Their success arose not only from devotion to traditional repertoire but also from innovative work. Gamelan Sekar Jaya is regarded as "the finest Balinese gamelan outside of Indonesia" (*Tempo* magazine) and is the only non-Balinese group to receive a *Dharma Kusuma*, Bali's highest award for artistic achievement.
