SAN FRANCISCO, CA— September 15, 2017—In their seventh season presenting free monthly dance performances in San Francisco City Hall's extraordinary Rotunda, Dancers' Group and World Arts West continue their partnership to bring audiences lunchtime glimpses into movement and musical traditions from around the world.

This November, Charya Burt Cambodian Dance will present *Celestial Flowers*, a sublime Rotunda blessing composed of two dance pieces: one from the classical repertory, *Chun Por;* and one of Burt's newest choreographies, *Heavenly Garden*, a 2016 San Francisco Ethnic Dance Festival premiere that brings to life the ancient concept of heavenly perfection. Highlighting Burt's two passions, cultural preservation and classical innovation, she will begin the program with a sacred prayer followed by *Chun Por (The Wishing Dance)*, traditionally performed to send blessings to the audience with flower petals tossed to offer happiness and prosperity. The program closes with a re-staging of *Heavenly Garden*, depicting the journey of a princess and her maidens in search of eternal beauty and how they embrace the majestic yet peaceful nature that surrounds them.

The Rotunda Dance Series brings many of the Bay Area's most celebrated dance companies to San Francisco City Hall for free monthly noon-time performances and is presented by Dancers' Group and World Arts West in partnership with Grants for the Arts and SF City Hall.

The 2017 Rotunda Dance Series will conclude with Nicaragua Danza, Hijos del Maíz on December 1.
