Rotunda Dance Series: Nava Dance Collective

SAN FRANCISCO, CA—February 13, 2017—In their seventh season of free monthly dance performances in San Francisco City Hall's extraordinary rotunda, Dancers' Group and World Arts West continue their partnership to bring audiences lunchtime glimpses into movement and musical traditions from around the world.

This March, Nava Dance Collective presents *Transcendence – Charkh e Falak (Turning of The Cosmos)*, a dance installation in honor of Nowruz (New Day), a celebration of the Spring equinox observed by peoples across the Middle East and Central Asia. This piece honors the ancient Zoroastrian sun deity, *Mithra*, and will feature a traditional Iranian *Haft-Seen* (a ritual altar built in homes during the time of Nowruz), along with an enactment of the rituals performed on Nowruz by *Anahita*, the ancient Persian goddess of water. Special guest artists include Persian percussionist Amir Etemadzadeh and dance artist Aliah Najmabadi.

Next up for the Rotunda Dance Series will be *One Dance*, a fun-filled flash mob led by Rhythm & Motion, celebrating the kick-off of Bay Area Dance Week, on Friday, April 21. The 2017 performance series will continue with presentations by the World Dance and World Music Programs at the Ruth Asawa San Francisco School for the Arts, Monaco Boys Choir, and Madhuri Kishore School of Kuchipudi, among others.

The Rotunda Dance Series continues to bring many of the Bay Area's most celebrated dance companies to San Francisco City Hall for free monthly noon-time performances and is presented by Dancers' Group and World Arts West in partnership with Grants for the Arts and SF City Hall.

Nava Dance Collective is an international community of dancers devoted to cross-cultural dialogue and artistic collaboration through traditional, sacred, and ethno-contemporary dance forms.
