The company's mission is to present Folkloric, Classical and informed-innovation dances based in and inspired by Near Eastern Dance, covering geographic regions from Turkey to Central Asia and from North Africa to the Middle East; and to present Near Eastern dance respectfully, with cultural sensitivity and authenticity.

Bal Anat was formed in 1968 by Jamila Salimpour out of a need for an organized presentation of the various Middle East dances at the Renaissance Pleasure Faire in Northern California. This provided Salimpour a means to present her many years of research on traditional Middle East dance folkloric dances. Her daughter, Suhaila Salimpour, resurrected Bal Anat in 2000 and continues to direct the performance company and run the Suhaila Salimpour School of Dance.
