SAN FRANCISCO, CA—In their ninth season of free monthly dance performances in San Francisco City Hall's extraordinary Rotunda, Dancers' Group and World Arts West continue their partnership to bring audiences lunchtime glimpses into movement and musical traditions from around the world.

Most recently, Nadhi and the company worked in partnership with Oakland-based visual artist Rupy C. Tut to create "*Broken Seeds Still Grow*," a bharatanatyam dance and visual art production inspired by the real-life stories from the 1947 Partition Archive and recent South Asian American history.

The Rotunda Dance Series brings many of the Bay Area's most celebrated dance companies to San Francisco City Hall for free monthly noon-time performances and is presented by Dancers' Group and World Arts West, in partnership with Grants for the Arts and SF City Hall.

Nava Dance Theatre, directed by Nadhi Thekkek, is a bharatanatyam dance company based in San Francisco, CA, which uses the classical South Indian dance form to explore and understand place, identity, and politics.
