SAN FRANCISCO, CA—In their tenth season of free monthly dance performances in San Francisco City Hall's extraordinary Rotunda, Dancers' Group and World Arts West continue their partnership to bring audiences lunchtime glimpses into movement and musical traditions from around the world.

This February, there will be an explosive performance by Robert Moses' Kin, a diverse company known for its eclectic movement vocabulary, demanding choreography, ferocious dancing, and provocative themes.

Moses' focus on the expressiveness of the human body and his desire to speak with the voices of his African American heritage have produced works with regional, national and international recognition.

The Rotunda Dance Series brings many of the Bay Area's most celebrated dance companies to San Francisco City Hall for free monthly noon-time performances and is presented by Dancers' Group and World Arts West, in partnership with Grants for the Arts and SF City Hall.

The 2020 Rotunda Dance Series will continue on Friday, Mar 27 at Noon.
